

Worker's Compensation Board of Indiana (INWCB) Announcement

Indiana Claims Release 3.1, Version 1.4 EDI Requirement Tables are Now Available!

INWCB has posted the Indiana EDI Claims Release 3.1, Version 1.4 EDI Requirement Tables (Rev: 8-13-19, Effective: 11-12-19) that are immediately available for download at https://inwcbedi.info/. You will find the updated tables under the "EDI Requirements" links on the left-hand side of the page. The changes to each document are located in the "INWCB Change Log" at the beginning of each document.

A few changes we would like to draw to your attention are as follows:

Event Table: A second SROI UI will now be accepted; however, this does not imply that IN will grant an extension. IN will manually review the 2nd UI extension request and Petition form. Please be advised that Indiana may grant the extension for less time than was requested. (This sequencing change has already been implemented)

Element Requirement Table and Edit Matrix: DN0400 - Cancel Reason Code and DN0402 - Cancel Reason Narrative will now be required for MTC 01 – Cancel Entire Claim.

Edit Matrix - Sequencing Tab: A SROI FN will now be allowed to follow a SROI UI if the Claim Type Code = M-Medical Only, and the claim was deemed compensable (not denied). If it is not a Medical Only claim, then the claim should have a subsequent SROI filed either for requesting additional time, indemnity payment or denial (SROI UI, IP, AP, EP, PY, 04). If the claim is a Medical Only Claim and is denied, a SROI 04 needs to be filed before a SROI FN. (This sequencing change has already been implemented).

We will also not permit more than 2 SROI UI's on a claim. (This sequencing change has already been implemented).

We will be publishing an easier Sequencing document that will address whether an MTC can follow another MTC. This will be published on or before the v1.4 implementation of 11/12/2019.
