## Indiana Claims Release 3.1, Version 1.1 Requirement Tables, EDI Implementation Guide and Testing Information Are Now Available!

IN WCB has posted the EDI Claims Release 3.1, Version 1.1 Requirement Tables (Revision Date: 9/29/2018), EDI Implementation Guide, Test Plan and Testing Feedback Request Form, which are immediately available for download at <a href="https://inwcbedi.info/">https://inwcbedi.info/</a>. You will find the updated requirement tables under the "EDI Requirements" link on the left-hand side of the page. On each of the tables, the Change Log has a column INWCB Implementation Date for Production. The updated INWCB EDI Implementation Guide is available under the "Implementation Guide" page. The Test Plan and Testing Feedback Request Form under "Implementation Info".

If you have not yet completed the Electronic Trading Partner Profile Registration for Release 3.1, **please register now!** To register, go to <a href="https://inwcbedi.info/register">https://inwcbedi.info/register</a>.

If you are already an approved Trading Partner in Indiana for *Release 1*, you must re-register as a new Trading Partner for *Release 3.1*.

Testing for mandatory reporting of IAIABC Claims Release 3.1 is ongoing and ends December 13, 2018. The Mandate Date for IN WCB EDI Claims Release 3.1 is January 1, 2019.

Implementation of the Indiana EDI Claims Version 1.1 Requirements will occur on the date indicated in the 'INWCB Implementation Date for Testing' column on the INWCB Change Log.

Please note that in Release 1, the Employee Last Name Suffix was contained in the Employee Last Name field. However, for all Release 3.1 filings, Employee Last Name Suffix must be reported in the separate field DN0255 - Employee Last Name Suffix.
