



Worker's Compensation Board of Indiana (IN WCB) Announcement

Indiana Claims Release 3.1, Updated EDI Event Table (v1.3) Now Available!

Date: March 15, 2019

The INWCB has updated their Event Table (v 1.3) (Revision Date: 3/15/2019) to clarify which MTC SX with Suspension Reason Code - Full (DN0418) is to be used to distinguish between Indiana Forms: Form 54217 - Notice of Suspension of Compensation and/or Benefits, and Form 38911 - Report of Temporary Total Disability (TTD)/ Temporary Partial Disability (TPD) Termination. In addition, INWCB will explain below how their paper forms generation will work for Claim Administrators.

Indiana has 2 paper forms that will be represented by the EDI MTC SX EDI transmission. Form [54217](#) titled Notice of Suspension of Compensation and/or Benefits and Form [38911](#) titled Report of Temporary Total Disability (TTD)/ Temporary Partial Disability (TPD) Termination. Indiana will be using Suspension Reason Code - Full (DN0418) to determine which paper filing is represented by the EDI SX electronic filing. MTC SX with Suspension Reason Code - Full SJ should always be used if a trading partner is filing the electronic equivalent of Form 54217, Notice of Suspension of Compensation and/or Benefits.

MTC SX with the applicable Suspension Reason Code - Full S1-S7 should be used if a trading partner is filing the electronic equivalent of Form 38911, Report of Temporary Total Disability (TTD)/ Temporary Partial Disability (TPD) Termination. Suspension Reason Code - Full S8, S9 and SD are not applicable in INWCB and will be grayed out in the next release of the Edit Matrix. INWCB doesn't anticipate the use of these codes; however, they will not be rejected until the implementation of the next release of the Edit Matrix.

INWCB will be partially shutting down their paper Forms Portal on 3/20/2019, with the exception of filing Form 54217 - Notice of Suspension of Compensation and/or Benefits. The forms portal will completely shut down for all forms effective 6/3/2019. The portal is being left open to allow trading partners to program for the implementation of the Suspension Reason Code - Full SJ as outlined above.

Please note that a paper Form 1043 for PPI payments will still be required to be filed with INWCB prior to issuing the PPI payment which would trigger the EDI PY MTC if paid in a lump sum.

All other forms that had previously been sent using INWCB's Forms Portal will now be represented by EDI SROI transactions. INWCB will take a submitted SROI and create a completed version of the appropriate form. A link to download and print this form will be emailed to the Claim Administrator Claim Representative E-mail Address (DN0138) submitted on the transaction. The email will have the subject of "Form name – SF Form number – JCN". For example, a UI transaction will trigger a 48557 Request for Additional Time. This would be sent with the subject of "Request for Additional Time – SF48557 – 9912345". Emails will be generated and sent on the same day that the SROI has been accepted.
